Please note that abstracts are not edited, but estimated by Review Commission after the deadline for receiving papers.

Submission of abstracts will be accepted until April 1, 2016

Publication of works is free.

Subject abstracts must match the name of the conference:

"Modern biotechnology for science and practice"

Rules for writing papers

- Abstracts submitted for publication in Russian or English.
- Abstracts should be typed in Word and carefully edited, as in the future will not be edited.
- Font Times New Roman, font size 12, 1.5 line spacing. Margins: left 30 mm, right 15 mm, top 25 mm, bottom 25 mm. Maximum total no more pages (about 2000 characters without spaces).
- Abstracts may comprise a single table. Figures do not include.
- The title should be in capital letters.
- Names and initials of authors are printed in uppercase and lowercase letters.
- The next line specifies the name of the institution, city and country. (Sample below):

Introduction. Start of text

- Works must contain specific factual scientific nature obtained by the author and include the following sections: *introduction, purpose and objectives, materials and methods, main results*, *the conclusion / findings*.
- Information in the writings of advertising is not permitted.
- Prepared files with the works sent by e-mail to the organizing committee dna day 2016@mail.ru
- One file should contain no more than one job. Submit no more than 3 works by one author. The maximum amount of a single file is not more than 2 MB.
